I chair Rāroa Marae Trust, hold leadership positions with Waimana Tribal and am on the Waimana School Board. I have whakapapa links through Ruātoki, Tāneatua and Waimana. It's the work I do in our communities which has led many people to ask me to stand for election.

If elected I'll be answerable to you. I'll bring a Taneatua, Ruatoki, Waimana voice and perspective to the Council table, combined with a Maori world view.

I currently work amongst tamariki and rangatahi as a Lay Advocate at Rangatahi Kooti and Whakatane Youth Court, provide Ministry of Social Development approved OSCAR services, and coach Waimana Senior Mens Rugby.
