



Overnight parking rubbish

Thank you for choosing the Whakatāne district for your overnight parking experience. We hope you enjoy everything the area has to offer.

We aim to keep our overnight parking areas as clean as possible for everyone to enjoy. You can help by managing your rubbish and recycling. While there are bins at our overnight parking areas, they are for litter only. If large amounts of rubbish or big items are put in these bins, they will fill up and no-one will be able to use them.

Please take your rubbish to one of our refuse transfer stations. At the Whakatāne Transfer Station it costs \$4 to dispose of a large bag of rubbish, while recycling is free. The Murupara Transfer Station offers free rubbish and recycling disposal services.

If you use our rubbish and recycling litter bins for the occasional piece of rubbish, please ensure you use them correctly.

- Red bins are for rubbish only - after you have taken out all your recycling.
- Blue bins are for clean glass bottles and jars.
- Yellow bins are for clean, mixed recycling (paper, cardboard, tins, cans, plastics). Please note we only accept grade 1 and 2 plastics in our mixed recycling.
- Look for the symbols -  
Any other plastics should go in your rubbish.

Murupara Transfer Station,
Harakeke Road, Murupara
Mon, Wed, Fri: 10am - 3pm
Tues and Thurs: 2.30 - 5pm
Weekends: 9am - 4pm

Both transfer stations are closed on Christmas Day, New Year's Day and Good Friday.
