CHECK THAT YOU QUALIFY TO APPLY FIRST

To hold a manager's certificate, you must:

- Be 20 years or older
- Have a Licence Controller Qualification (LCQ) certificate or LCQ Bridging Test certificate
- Be working in a licensed premise
- have at least six (6) months experience supervising a licensed premise in New Zealand.

The prescribed fee of \$316.25 (includes GST at 15%). This fee is non-refundable

A copy of your photo Identification

A copy of your LCQ certificate

A copy of your LCQ Bridging Test certificate (if applicable)

A letter from your employer or your club, confirming that you are employed there

A character reference letter from a person who has known you for a minimum of five years and is not associated with the licensed premise

A NZ Police Authorisation form, signed and dated

To complete this application, you will need to answer all questions that follow and supply all of the

Note:

- 1. Failure to supply all of the required documents may result in the application being returned
- 2. Once you have lodged this application with the Council, we will contact you to attend an interview with an alcohol licensing Inspector.

THE IMPACT OF THE CRIMINAL RECORDS (CLEAN SLATE) ACT 2004 ON APPLICATIONS FOR MANAGER'S CERTIFICATES UNDER THE SALE AND SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL ACT 2012

The Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Act 2004 commenced on Monday 29 November 2004. The Act enables individuals who satisfy all of the eligibility criteria to conceal all f their convictions in most circumstances. It sets a high threshold for eligibility

The general criteria for obtaining the benefits of the `clean slate' scheme are set out below. Section 7 of the Act should be consulted for full information.

The individual must have:

- No convictions within the last seven years;
- Never been sentenced to a custodial sentence (eg imprisonment, corrective training, borstal)
- Never been ordered by a Court during a criminal case to be detained in a hospital due to his/her mental condition, instead of being sentenced
- Paid in full any fine, reparation or costs ordered by the Court in a criminal case;
- Never been indefinitely disqualified from driving under section 65 of the Land Transport Act 1998 or an
 earlier equivalent provision (section 65 relates to mandatory penalties for repeat offences involving use of
 alcohol or drugs
