- 1. I agree to an Animal Control officer visiting my property to do a property inspection before adoption and as a follow up visit to check the adoption is going successfully.
- I accept that the Whakatāne District Council has taken steps to ensure the general good health of the dog and is not held responsible for any disease or illness that may develop after leaving the care of the Whakatāne District Council.
- 3. I will ensure that the dog is loved (treated humanely and with respect,) and well cared for and that I will be a responsible dog owner and ensure my dog is not a nuisance to neighbours and other people by abiding by the Dog Control act 1996 and the Animal Welfare Act 1999.
- 4. I understand that failure to comply with the above may result in the animal being uplifted by an Animal Control Officer and the adoption withdrawn at any time.
- 5. I authorise the Whakatāne District Council to seek further information from the relevant Councils in relation to my animal ownership history and to verify the information provided on this form.
- 6. I authorise the Whakatāne District Council to contact my current landlord in regards to the keeping of a dog on the property.
