- New stacking lane will open for traffic turning left from the bridge into Landing Road
- Hinemoa Street will re-open
- Hinemoa traffic will be able to enter Landing Road via a right turn at the roundabout
- Final asphaltting, line marking and landscaping will continue through the coming weeks
- Please drive with caution as we all adjust to the new road layouts around the Landing Road neighbourhood

ALL TEMPORARY LAYOUT CHANGES WILL BE REMOVED

Temporary road layout changes to the Landing Road neighbourhood including Landing Road, Hawera Street, Victoria Avenue, Nelson Street and James Street will be removed and returned to normal.
