APPLICATION FOR A "NO SPRAY ZONE"

In joining the No Spray Register, the resident agrees to take over the responsibility for:

- Eradicating all noxious and undesirable plants;
- Keeping the road frontage clear and tidy;
- Keeping drainage paths free of obstruction and fully operational at all times;
- Keeping vegetation cleared from around signs, posts and other roadside furniture where the mower cannot reasonably reach. A radius of one metre is appropriate in most cases; and
- Ensuring that the "no-spray" markers are in place and remain clearly visible to the spraying contractor.

Note: If these conditions are not maintained and the spraying contractor sees an overgrown frontage, then the operator is required to spray the area as normal.

I agree to comply with the conditions described above and understand that if, in the opinion of the

spraying contractor, the conditions are not being met the area will be sprayed.

¹ A Route Position is the distance from the start of a road to an obstacle, or in this case, the start and end of the no-spray zone. Route Positions can be measured using a trip meter in a vehicle. Sometimes culverts are marked with their Route Positions (on a marker) so if you have one near the zone it will help the Contractor establish the area you are requesting.

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
