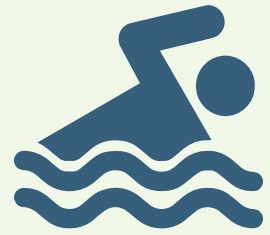

## Frequently asked questions



### What fees are changing?

#### Child and Beneficiary Admission

The current admission charge is \$3.50 with a new proposed charge of \$3.60. The change is being made to adjust for inflation. Although the change is minimal, it has been recommended to keep pace with inflation to help prevent large increases in the future.

#### Student and Senior Admission

The current admission charge for both students and seniors are \$3.50. This is noticeably lower than other facilities across New Zealand, which is why a new price of \$5 is being proposed. This is still \$2 less than the standard adult price of \$7.

#### Shower Fee

The current shower charge is \$2 which is considerably lower than most facilities. It is being proposed that the new charge be \$5, which is in line with other facilities.

#### Energy Surcharge

To help mitigate rising energy costs, a 30-cent energy surcharge is proposed to all single admission pool fees (including concession cards).

#### Other

All other fees and charges have been adjusted by the rate of inflation.
