During my early years my family Rini whanau resided adjacent to Te Hokowhitu atu, I lived there 1955 - 1973 and left at the age of 23.

At the age of approx 10 years old I witnessed the dumping of materials from the whatatane Board mills on the now proposed residential site. This dumping area spanned from the access corner across to 50 metres within the private whanau drivenay.

During the flood season (normal late to early years) this block would flood and the residue of this dumping would float to the top of the flooded water. As children we would play on this materiel and we named this shakey island. Myself as well as most of my siblings and cousins waded through this materiel.

years later, on returning to my papakaingar we were made aware of the true extent of contamination.

1 have a daughter who had cancer at the age of 8 years old ishe has thankfully stabilised, but is unable to bear children

I have every intention to return to the papakaingator whanau gatherings of our traditional cultural practices. It is for two reasons that I support the submission in opposition to development of residental zoning.

I am aware of the high levels of cancer within our whanau and associated medical problems.

My opposition is made to make aware of the contamination I witnessed and is for the benefit of the wider community. I am not convioced adequate testing has been conducted, in particular the area I mentioned also
