From Friday, anyone who still needs to dispose of flood-affected household contents, or strip-out floor and wall linings, can contact Whakatāne District Council Customer Services on 07 306 0500.

Waste removal services will still be supplied to support the work of the Liveable Homes Project and Task Force Green. Waste services relating to the rebuild process remain the responsibility of contractors.

To dispose of greenwaste from garden tidy-ups - please use your kerbside greenwaste bin, or take material to the Whakatāne Transfer Station, Te Tahi St, Whakatāne.
