



Widening of concrete path to 1.8m to meet boardwalk and addition of new path from south King of 80 lineal metres to meet existing path.

Continued investigation of private stormwater discharges and options for removal if required.

Extension of pathway of 1.8m wide beyond the boardwalk to meet Olympic Drive. Possible further pathway development around eastern side of lake to meet shared-use path in accordance with Active Whakatane Strategy dependant on funding.

Maintain program for key structure audits and renewals (footbrige and boardwalk).

Continue to investigate alternatives for improving water quality - eg floating wetlands/aeration etc.

Maintain and continue monitoring of solid waste collection services.

Continued vegetation maintenance and management.

Maintain new signage at King, South Douglas, East Douglas and off Olympic Drive. Investigate further native flora and fauna and historical interpretation.

Renewal program of hard edges where banked natural edging is not practical.

Continued replacement of specimen park trees (in accordance with updated Urban Tree Strategy) and native wetland plant species on lake margin.

Undertake investigations in to programme for silt removal according to bathymetric survey.

Investigate alternative barriers to chain across new pathway - for greater accessibility but to discourage vehicles.

Possible future development of 2.5-3m wide shared-use pathway connecting King to South Douglas to East Douglas in accordance with the Active Whakatane Strategy and dependant on external funding streams.

Collate key water parametres - e-coli, PH, suspended solids, hardness, turbidity and some metals. Reporting of cyanobacterial counts via Regional Council monitoring systems.

Reinforcement and replanting of bund for further stormwater and silt management.

New picnic table and renewal of playground equipment - new decks, cushion fall and painting. Continued independant and internal playground structure audits.

Maintain a program of silt removal at southern end of lake as required.

Continued fresh-water introduction in to lake during Oct-March as necessary in accordance with consent.
