


- Apply Christchurch learnings

Lease remissions



Scope

Ground rent remission available when undertaking building strengthening works

Policy parameters

- Applies to ground rent only <u>not</u> rates
- Applies to strengthening of buildings with NBS < 100% ie categories A, B, C, D,
- Applies where strengthening works negatively impact on rental streams
- Does not apply retrospectively to works already undertaken

Process

- Building Owner submits application to Building Consents team
- Building Owner continues to receive invoices/statements from Council
- Building Consents determine extent of "loss of rents" upon completion of works
- Council issues credit note reflecting "loss of rents"
- Building Owner elects to receive refund or apply credit to next invoice

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Detailed Seismic Assessments



- Benefits from Council project managing the DSA process:
 - Technical expertise required to engage engineer and interpret DSA findings
 - Economies of scale generate cost savings for Building Owners eg \$2-3k per bldg
 - Consistent assessment methodology simpler to review and challenge results
