Council has matched this using the harbour fund, so there's now more than \$20 million available for town centre and riverfront redevelopment (including wharves package), with no impact on rates. ### Car parking

Parking is a huge issue. We hear this. Council is taking a strategic approach to how we continue to provide parking in the CBD so that people can access the town centre to shop, go to work, do business and for entertainment.

#### We might need to reconfigure parking in the CBD; however, there are no plans to reduce the overall number of spaces available.

Kākahoroa Drive parking area is probably the most strategic piece of land available for a potential refresh of our CBD. What we are asking people to do is to think about how this area could function if we use some of it to reconnect with the river, create event spaces, green spaces and/or open up development for river-facing business, residential and entertainment premises. (And create alternative, convenient parking spaces in other places).
